

MIXED PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- **will have access to the freedoms allowed under the Reopening NSW roadmap. Only fully vaccinated people and those with medical exemptions**

- Team to comprise one man and one lady
- Three bowl SETS PLAY
- Two sets 9 of ends plus tie breaker if necessary (three ends)
- One rollup each way before first set only
- No dead ends. Out of bounds jacks are to be placed on the "T"
- Result is determined by sets
- Shared set counts as ½ point

FIRST SET

- Toss for the mat. Winner of the toss may give the mat away first end only
- All nine ends are to be played

SECOND SET

- Winner of last end in first set is to roll the jack at first end of the second set
- All ends to be played unless agreed otherwise by teams

TIE BREAK

- In the event that scores are level after two sets, a tie break will be played
- Three ends all shots count
- Toss for the mat. Winner of toss may give the mat away first end only
- In the event scores being equal after three ends a fourth end will be played

EXTRA END (where required)

- Toss for the mat. Winner of toss may give the mat away
- This continues until a team cannot tie or win

UNABLE TO PLAY

- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event on the stated date.
- This event is to be played to the rules and conditions of Bowls Australia and the RNSWBA except as decided by the controlling body.
