- Ladies graded 3 will be equivalent to Men's Grade 6 and Ladies graded 4 will be equivalent to Men's Grade 7.
- This event is limited to the time period allocated on the yearly planner.
- Each round will be played on its scheduled date.
- 2 Substitutes or replacements will be allowed all efforts must be made to fit the points criteria if unable to find a suitable replacement contact the controlling body for assistance and approval.
- There will be two sections playing round robin.
- Winner of a section = Most Points if points are equal then Margin if margin equal then ends.

Win = 4 points TIE or NO PLAY = 2 points FORFEIT -4 points

## BOWLER OF THE YEAR POINTS

- Top team in each section will play the FINAL and receive winner and runner-up points.
- Second team in each section will play for Semi-Final Loser points and Quarter Final Loser Points.
- All other teams will compete against teams from opposite section on FINAL DAY.
- Only 4 constituted players will receive points.
- Random draw for Section and Team number.
- 2022 Club Pennant uniform must be worn.
- 2 bowl fours
- 1 end rollup each way.
- 21 ENDS
- Dead Ends to be replayed.
