HANDICAP PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Four bowl conventional pairs
- 21 ENDS
- One rollup each way
- Dead Ends to be replayed
- Handicaps will be determined by the Selectors
- Handicap formula will be on the notice board
- The selectors may use their discretionary powers in extenuating circumstances to change a grading
- The selectors will notify the Controlling Body / Match Committee of the handicaps and any changes before they are added to the draw.
- Substitutes and Replacements if approved by controlling body. The affected team will have their handicap recalculated accordingly

UNABLE TO PLAY

- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls
 Organiser. If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser and Match Committee.
- Entrants who withdraw without playing a game will be charged the \$5 Entrance fee.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
- This event is to be played to the rules and Conditions of Play Bowls Australia and the RNSWBA except as decided by the controlling body.
