## MIXED PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Team to comprise one man and one lady.
- Three bowl SET PLAY
- Two sets 9 of ends plus tie breaker if necessary (three ends)
- One rollup each way before the first set only.
- Rollup 20 minutes before starting time.
- No dead ends. Out of bounds jacks are to be placed on the "T".
- Result is determined by sets.
- Shared set counts as $1 / 2$ point

FIRST SET

- Toss for the mat. Winner of the toss may give the mat away first end only.
- There must be no further play in set, if it becomes impossible for a team to draw or win the set.


## SECOND SET

- Winner of the first set must place the mat then deliver the jack and first bowl.
- If the first set is a draw the winner of the last scoring end in that set must play first.
- There must be no further play in set, if it becomes impossible for a team to draw or win the set.


## TIE BREAK

- In the event that scores are level after two sets, a tie break will be played
- Three ends all shots count.
- Toss for the mat. Winner of toss may give the mat away first end only.
- In the event scores being equal after three ends a fourth end will be played.
- There must be no further play in set, if it becomes impossible for a team to draw or win the set.


## EXTRA END (where required)

- Toss for the mat. Winner of toss may give the mat away.
- This continues until a team cannot tie or win.


## UNABLE TO PLAY

- There is no order of precedence for this event, should you be unable to play on The scheduled date or as stated in these COPs for any reason, A substitute Must be found.
- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. (If this is not done the game will be invalid) If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e., the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser and Match Committee.


## GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
- This event is to be played to the rules and Conditions of Play Bowls Australia and the Bowls N.S.W except as decided by the controlling body.
