GRADED FOURS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Limited to 12 teams (first teams entered with all positions nominated)
 - Minimum 20 points from 2022-2023 Open Pennant season NO EXCETIONS.
Grade 5 bowlers limited to no more than 3 bowlers per team.
Anyone without a grade the selectors will allocate a grade.
 - Ladies graded 3 will be equivalent to Men's Grade 6 and Ladies graded 4 will be equivalent to Men's Grade 7.
 - This event is limited to the dates allocated on the yearly planner.
 - Each round will be played on its scheduled date.
 - 2 Substitutes or replacements will be allowed each round with approval from the controlling body.
-
- There will be two sections playing round robin.
 - Winner of a section = Most Points if points are equal then Margin if margin equal then ends.
Win = 4 points TIE or NO PLAY = 2 points FORFEIT -4 points
 - A side receiving a forfeit shall be awarded 4 points and a +15 shots.
 - A side forfeiting a game will be reduced by 4 points and -15 shots.
 - Semi-Final: Winner of section 1 to play runner-up section 2,
Winner of section 2 to play runner-up section 1.
 - FINAL: Winners of Semi-Finals.
 - Bowler of the year points winner 35 points, Runner-up 18 points,
Semi-Final losers 9 points. Quarter-Final points to teams finishing third in each section.
Maximum of four constituted players from each team to receive points.
- Random draw for Section and Team number.
 - 2022-2023 Open Pennant club uniform must be worn.
 - 2 bowl fours.
 - 1 end rollup each way.
 - 18 ENDS.
 - No Dead Ends Jack on Tee.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play.
- **UNABLE TO PLAY**
- This is not a championship event and does not have order of priority.
- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.
