OPEN HANDICAP PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Four bowl conventional pairs
- 21 ENDS
- Cards called 20 minutes before, and rollups completed by start time.
- One rollup each way.
- Dead Ends to be replayed.
- Handicaps will be based on bowlers open pennant grade.
 Bowlers with no open pennant grade the selectors will allocate a grade.
- Ladies without an open pennant grade. Depending on the ladies pennant grade they will be given equivalent to open pennant grade 6 or 7.
- All bowler's grades and the handicap formula will be placed on the notice board after the end of Pennant Round 7.
- Substitutes and Replacements if approved by controlling body. The affected team will have their handicap recalculated accordingly. (They must not be below the lowest handicap)

UNABLE TO PLAY

 All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. (If this is not done the game will be invalid) If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e., the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser and Match Committee.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
- This event is to be played to the rules and Conditions of Play Bowls Australia and the Bowls N.S.W except as decided by the controlling body.
