HANDICAP PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- This is an open gender Knockout event.
- The Match Committee may accept late entries to fill a vacant position in the draw caused by:
A withdrawal up until 24 hours prior to the commencement of Round 1.
- Players may practice up to thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- Cards called 20 minutes before, and rollups completed by start time.
- Four bowls per player in the order lead two bowls, skip two bowls and repeat
- One rollup each way.
- Played over 18 ends.
- No dead ends instead the jack should be placed at the spot two metre from the ditch and on the centre line and play should continue.
- There is no order of precedence for this event.
- Handicaps will be based on bowlers open pennant grade.
Bowlers with no open pennant grade the selectors will allocate a grade.
Bowlers grades and the handicap formula will be placed on the noticeboard.
- Substitutes and replacements will be allowed if approved by the Match Committee.
The affected team will have their handicap recalculated accordingly by the controlling body.
(they must not be below the lowest handicap)

UNABLE TO PLAY

- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date, however where circumstances prevail a bowler can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. (if this is not done the game will be invalid)
If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
- This event is to be played to the rules and conditions of Bowls Australia and the Bowls N.S.W except as decided by the controlling body.
