

MINOR PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Minor Pairs may be contested by members of the CMBC & CWBC Who have not won a Major or Minor Pairs Championship.

- This event maybe sectional, knockout or a combination of both depending on the numbers. Games and may be scheduled am, pm or both as required.
There is no order of precedence for this event.
- Four bowl conventional pairs 2 x 2 x 2 x2.
This event shall be played over 18 Ends.
- Two end roll up.
- No dead ends. Jack to be re spotted on the T.

UNABLE TO PLAY

- All matches are to be played under the club's "play or forfeit' rule i.e. play on or before the due date.

However, where circumstances prevail a team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser.

If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling Body for this event is the Match Committee present.
All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be Final.
The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
- This event is to be played to rules and conditions of Bowls Australia and Bowls N.S.W COP except as decided by the Controlling Body
