

CAMDEN BOWLING CLUB

GRADED FOURS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Minimum 19 points from 2025 - 2026 Open Pennant season NO EXCETCTIONS.
Grade 5 bowlers limited to no more than 3 x bowlers per team.
Anyone without a grade will allocate a grade on request to the Match Committee.
- Ladies without an Open Pennant Grade will be graded with a Women's Divisional Pennants Grade.
Ladies in Division 3 will be equivalent to Open Grade 4 and Ladies in Division 4 will be equivalent a Open Pennant Grade 6.
- This event is limited to the dates allocated on the draw.
- Each round will be played on its scheduled date.
- 2 Substitutes or replacements will be allowed for each team in each round with approval from the controlling body.
- Number of sections will be decided by the number of entries.
- Finishing order = Win Points plus Ends equals Total Points. If Total Points are equal then Margins.
WIN = 20 points TIE = 10 points Ends Won 1 point. NO PLAY = 0 points
- A side receiving a forfeit shall be awarded 30 points and a margin of +15 shots.
- A side forfeiting a game will be reduced by 30 points and a margin of -15 shots.
- Finals format to be decided by the Match Committee depending on the number of sections.
- Bowler of the year points winner 35 points, Runner-up 18 points,
Semi-Final losers 9 points.
Maximum of four constituted players from each team to receive points.
- Random draw for Sections and Team number.
- Dress code applies. Current club uniform must be worn.
- 2 bowl fours.
- 1 end rollup each way.
- 18 ENDS.
- No Dead Ends Jack on Tee.
- In the event of a game being stopped with less than 12 ends played due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen circumstance as decided by the Controlling Body, and is unable to be resumed on the day, it will be declared a washout and no play. Should all games on the day have played 12 end or more and the game is stopped as described above, and not completed on the day, it will be declared a completed game.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play.
- UNABLE TO PLAY
- This is not a championship event and does not have order of priority.

All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.
