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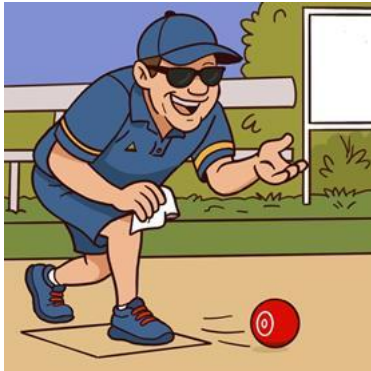
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Mastering the Mind in Lawn Bowls

Bowling success isn't just about technique or physical skill — it's about **what happens above the neck**. The best players understand that mental strength, focus, and composure are just as important as accuracy and power.



Every bowler can benefit from developing the Five C's of mental mastery:

1. **Concentration** – Stay fully focused on the shot in front of you. Block out distractions and maintain a clear head.
2. **Confidence** – Trust in your skills, training, and preparation. Believing in yourself allows you to execute shots with precision under pressure.
3. **Control** – Manage both your **weight** and your **emotions**. A steady hand and a calm mind prevent mistakes caused by tension or frustration.
4. **Consistency** – Practice and routine create reliable performance. Great leads and skips don't rely on luck—they repeat their best shots consistently.
5. **Composure** – Mistakes happen, even for elite players. Learn to **move on from a bad bowl**. You cannot change what has already happened, but you **can learn from it and approach the next shot with a fresh mindset**. Letting go of past errors keeps your focus sharp and your performance strong
