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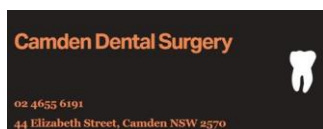

If a bowl at rest or a

toucher in the ditch is displaced by a player and it has not disturbed the head after it is

displaced, the opponent must put the bowl back to its former position.

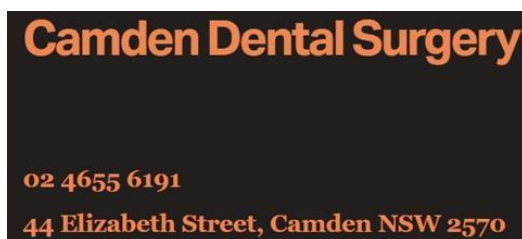
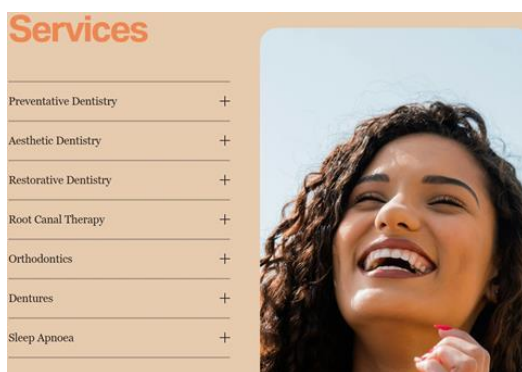
