State Champion of Champion Men's Singles
Conditions of Play

Match Formats Clubs may conduct Championships as knockout, sectional or a combination of both.

The Match Committee may accept late entries to fill a vacant position in the draw caused by: A withdrawal up until 24 hours prior to the commencement of Round 1.

This event is to be played under Bowls New South Wales 2026 Conditions of Play.

All matches are to be played as four bowls per player, and as the first to score 25 shots - Shots in excess of 25 do not count.

Allocation of Points Win 3 Points - Tie (Draw) 1 Point - Loss 0 Points.

Allocation of Points for Forfeited Matches a player receiving a forfeit shall be credited with a win (3 points). If a player forfeits a match in sectional play, all matches in that section involving the forfeiting player shall be declared a forfeit, with no results recorded for the player receiving the forfeit.

Sectional Standings The winner of the sectional series of matches shall be determined as follows:

The player scoring the highest number of points shall be declared the winner.

If two or more players are equal on points, the player with the largest difference between 'total shots for' and 'total shots against' shall be the winner.

If there is still a tie, the player with the lowest 'total shots against' shall be the winner.

If two players or teams remain tied, the winner of the match between those players shall be declared the winner.

If there is still a tie in singles, the player to have conceded the least number of ends shall be the winner.

If two players remain tied, there will be a drawing of lots by the Controlling Body to determine final section placings.

Players may practice up to thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start time.

Cards called 20 minutes before, and rollups completed by start time.

One rollup each way.

Dead Ends to be replayed.

Club's official uniform must be worn.

UNABLE TO PLAY

Knockout matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. (If this is not done the game will be invalid) If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e., the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser and Match Committee.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

This event is to be played under Bowls New South Wales 2026 Conditions of Play.

Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.

All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.

The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.
