BOWLS LAW: In a triples game the seconds are looking at the head deciding who has shot when the lead of team A indicates they are down. The seconds

then decide to measure. The skip of Team B claims that Team A have declared the head, and no measuring should take place. Is he right?

Answer: No. Under law 22.2 both sides must agree on shots scored. No player from Team B agreed that they had the shot.
