BOWLS LAW: In a tight head the third of Team A indicates to his skip who is standing on the mat, that they have the shot and to not play his last bowl. The skip instructs him to declare the head and rolls his last bowl down the rink. Both thirds watch as the bowl hits the head. Do they still score the shot the third indicated?

Answer: Under Law 25 the skips last bowl should have been stopped as a dead bowl. By declaring the head, he has elected not to play it. As it subsequently disturbed the head Law 37.3.4.2 and law 38.3.3 apply and the head should be placed back where it was before the skippers bowl disturbed it. If the thirds cannot agree then the end is dead.
