<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> At Saturday social bowls in Camden a jack is driven into the ditch and out of bounds. The third from Team A picks it up and places it on the 'T' as he did on Thursday. The third from Team B says "no this is Saturday and that means a dead end." Who is correct and why?

Answer: The third from Team B. Under law 57.2 the Controlling body can make local rules governing local conditions and requirements. In Camden on Tuesday and Thursday a dead jack goes on the 'T' (Conditions of Play) but on Saturday it is a dead end under law 19.1.2
