Answer: Any player at the head can choose to lift bowls to allow the moving bowl to pass or stop the bowl from the neighboring rink if there are too many bowls to lift. Laws 37.6.1.1; 37.6.1.2 If it is going to hit the jack it must be stopped. You cannot lift a jack. Law 38.6
