<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> On a very windy day Team A is holding shot when an especially big gust blows the jack sideways. Team B now has two shots. The skip of team B wants to leave it as is, but the skip of Team A wants to declare a dead end. Who is correct?

Neither. Under law 35 a jack moved by wind or storm is returned to its original spot before it moved. Correction: Under Domestic Regulations for Australia, Game Basics 1.3 a rebounding jack must be over 18 meters from the mat to be legal not 20 as claimed last week.
