<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> The skipper of team A drives at the jack, misses and the bowl rebounds off the bank back onto the green and touches the jack. His third marks the bowl as a toucher but the third of team B objects as the bowl came off the rear bank. Who is correct?

The third of team B. The bowl is dead and the jack must be replaced to its original position by the third of team B. Law 17.1.1 and Law 38.5.2 (N.B. if a Jack rebounds onto the rink after hitting the back bank it is still live. Law21.1)
