<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> In a singles game Player A plays a weighted shot that misses and is about to go into the ditch when the marker picks it up and places it on the bank. Player A then wants the bowl back to replay the shot as it was not a dead bowl when it was picked up. Player B objects saying that they both could see it was going into the ditch. Who is correct? Answer: Player A. The Bowl in course was displaced by a neutral person (the marker) so under Law 37.3.1.1 it is replayed. Under Law 17 a bowl is live until it is a) in the ditch, b)out of bounds or c) less than 14 metres from the mat.
