# **BOWLS LAW:**

With his first bowl the second from team A delivers a bowl which ends up right alongside the jack but does not touch it. The second from team B delivers his second bowl when team A's bowl falls onto the jack. Team A skipper marks the bowl as a toucher. Is he correct?

Answer: No. Once it comes to rest a falling bowl is only a toucher if it falls before the next bowl is delivered. Law 14.2.1
