<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> With his last bowl the skip of Team A drives at the head and hits the jack out of bounds. The end is dead and as all bowls are at one end the skip of Team A wants to play from that end, but the skip of Team B wants to play in the same direction as the previous end as his team is playing better in that direction. Who is correct?

A: The skip of Team B. Under law 20.2 a dead end is played in the same direction as the killed end unless by agreement. (All bowls must be returned to the mat end in a manner to not disturb players on other rinks.)
