<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> Several ends have been played when the Skip of Team A asks his third to play an upshot. The third goes to get a bowling arm with which to play the shot. The third of Team B objects as the player has not used the arm from the beginning of the game. Is he correct?

Answer: Not entirely. Under Bowls Australia Artificial Devices Policy 5.1.4 the player may commence using a bowling arm halfway through a game but he must keep on using it from then on for all shots.
