<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> The leads in a game of pairs have delivered their bowls when it is noticed that both the mat and the jack were placed on the wrong lines. Do they continue play, place both the mat and jack onto the correct line or declare the end dead and start again?

Answer: None of the above. The mat is placed on the correct line Law 6.2.3 but the jack stays where it is Law 9.7 will count.
