BOWLS LAW: The second of Team A sends his bowl down and it rests very closely alongside the jack. The second of Team B has delivered his bowl when the first bowl falls over and touches the jack. Team A skipper moves forward to mark the bowl but the opposing skipper objects. Who is correct?

Answer:

Team B skipper. Under law 14.2.1 for the bowl to be a toucher it must touch the jack before the next bowl is delivered.
