BOWLS LAW: During a pennant match the skipper of Team A drives the jack out of bound with his last bowl. The end is dead Law 19.1.2 and must be replayed. As all the bowls are at one end he instructs his players to place the mat and deliver the jack. The skipper from Team B objects and wants all the bowls to come back to the original end. Who is correct?

Answer: The Skipper from Team B. Under law 20.2 a dead end must be replayed in the same direction unless the skips agree to play otherwise. All bowls must be transferred back to the original end in a manner which avoids distracting players on neighbouring rinks.
