<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> A bowl is played wide and hits the foot of a player on the adjacent rink as they change ends. It then comes back onto the rink and moves the jack. Does the jack stay where it has been moved to?

No. The jack must be replaced to its original position and the bowl replayed. If the thirds or skips cannot agree on the original position then the end is dead. Law 37.3.1.4
