**BOWLS LAW:** In a social game an elderly player mistimes his delivery, and the bowl does not travel far. However, it is on the line of successive bowls. Team A is holding shot and the skip wants the bowl left there as it is blocking a shot to the jack. The skip of Team B wants the bowl removed as it is short of a legal length end. What should they do?

Answer: they should measure the short bowl. Under law 17.1.3 if it is less than 14 meters from the mat it is a dead bowl and under law 17.4 it is removed from the rink. Otherwise, it stays there.
