<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> On a busy afternoon when Championship Fours is being played a duck lands on the green. The Lead of Team A places the mat and rolls the jack thinking the bird will fly off but it doesn't, and the jack hits the duck. The lead of Team B wants to re-deliver the jack as it hit the duck short of a legal end. Can he do this?

Answer: No. The duck is a neutral object so Under Law 38.3.1 the lead of Team A rolls the jack again.
