<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> In a pairs game the lead of Team A rolls the jack out of bounds. It is then noticed that the mat was placed on the wrong line. The skip of Team A instructs his lead to roll the jack again, but the skip of Team B wants his lead to roll the jack. Who is correct?

Answer: The Skip of Team B. Under laws 10.1.2 and 10.2 if the jack is rolled out of bounds the opposing player then rolls the jack. Under law 6.1.3 if it is noticed that the mat is incorrectly placed before the first bowl is delivered then the opposing player places the mat and rolls the jack but does not play first.
