BOWLS LAW: The jack on rink 5 is in the ditch near the rink boundary. The next bowl from that rink looks like it is about to run over the mat on rink 6 which is well down the green. Should the player on rink 6 stop the bowl and send it back or lift the mat and allow it to pass?

Answer: He must lift the mat. Law 6.2.5
