<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> In a game of triples the Lead of Team A and the second of Team B are both playing with white bowls. The lead of Team A draws a toucher with his second bowl. The second of Team B then declares that the toucher is his bowl. The Skip of Team B wants to leave it as is. The Skip of Team A wants to return the bowl and the correct bowl to be played. Who is correct?

Answer: Neither. under law 29.2 the toucher is replaced with the correct bowl and that is marked as a toucher. The wrong bowl is then returned to the player.
