The third of Team B claims it is a dead end and they have the jack as the opposition lead is playing with an arm but did not put the jack down with it. All shots must be played with the arm.

Answer: Under Bowls Australia Artificial Devices Policy 5.1.4 the use of an artificial device does not apply to the rolling of the Jack which can be rolled either by hand or bowlers arm.
