BOWLS ETIQUETTE: On sunny days be aware of where your shadow is. Do not allow it to cover the jack as this can upset distance judgment.

Avoid standing in front of the rink markers. Players use these as a guide for grass line.

When changing ends allow the last player to deliver to be able to watch his bowl until it comes to rest just as you have done. Do not walk in front of him.
