<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> The skipper from Team A plays a weighted shot into a short end but misses and his bowl comes to rest on the boundary line well down the green. The thirds are undecided whether the bowl is in or out of the rink. One third wants to call the umpire but the other objects as the bowl is so far from the head and thinks that is a waste of time. Who is correct?

Answer: Under law 17.3 a decision does not have to be made until the bowl comes into play. The umpire should then be called.
