<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> On a short end with the mat up the green the skip of Team A drives at the jack but the jack bounces off a bowl and rolls back towards the mat. The skip of Team B claims a dead end as the jack appears to be short of a legal length end. Is he correct?

No. A legal length end is 21 meters but under Appendix B.4.2 a rebounding jack can be 20 meters from the mat as long as it is within the confines of the rink.
