<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> The lead of Team A rolls the jack and puts down his first bowl when the skip of team B declares the jack is too short. He picks the jack up and rolls it back to his leader to put the jack down on a longer end. The skip of team A objects as he likes short ends. What happens?

Under law 9.7 no one has the right to challenge the position of the jack after the first bowl is played therefore the end is legal. The jack was displaced by an opposing player therefore under law 38.1.3 it is replaced on its original spot.
