**BOWLS LAW:** The third of team A delivers his bowl and as it goes down the rink it makes contact with another bowl and then goes on to touch the jack. As the skip of team A is going to mark the bowl the skip of team B objects saying that as the bowl touched another before the jack it is no longer 'in its original course' as described in the laws. Is he correct?

Answer: No. Under Definitions C.15 a bowl is in its original course no matter how many times it touches other bowls or the jack until it comes to rest or is dead.
