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<u>BOWLS LAW:</u> On a windy day where the draw on one side of the rink is narrow and the other is wide a player notices other players lifting bowls to allow bowls from the next rink to pass through their head. Then a bowl on the wrong bias is about to hit his jack so he lifts the jack allowing the bowl to pass. Did he do the right thing?

Answer: NO. Under law 38.6 he should have stopped the bowl. Being on the wrong bias the bowl is dead and should have been stopped, Law 17.1.5. The bowls being lifted were in danger of being moved by a bowl from an adjoining rink Law 37.6.1.1
