

Player Financial Support Policy



CAMDEN MENS BOWLING CLUB inc.

Outline

The Camden Mens Bowling Club encourages its players to compete at higher grades of competition by supporting them financially and rewarding success by contributing to the reasonable expenses of winning teams.

This support shall be limited to travel and accommodation. No support will be given for meals, drinks or any other social activity.

The club will provide light refreshments for all players and managers following home pennant games.

Definitions

A Nepean Highlander competition is one organised and controlled by the Nepean Highlander Region which is played at local clubs and where the winning team is entitled to play in the Bowls NSW run State Finals which could be played anywhere in the state.

A State Competition is one which is run by Bowls NSW and although qualifying events may be played locally no local organisation has any area of control.

A National Competition is run by Bowls Australia and can be played anywhere in Australia.

A pennant team consists of 12 players, one reserve and one manager.

What we will do

Pennants

The club will pay entry fees for all teams nominating to play in the Nepean Highlander Pennant Competition(s)

Travel allowance to weekly pennant competitions will be paid to skippers according to the following table.

However, if a team wins the pennant for their grade the club will pay each player \$150 per playing day if accommodation is required to compete in the State Finals. This amount is considered to include any travel required.

In the event the host club of a State Final includes lunch as part of the fixture this will be paid for by CMBC

If the relevant State Final is played within 100 km of Camden support shall be limited to travel and lunch for each day played. Travel shall be paid 50 cents per kilometre from CBC to and from the venue of the competition.

Region Competitions

The club will pay the entry fee for each member wanting to compete in Nepean Highlander Region competitions.

If the member nominates and does not play the first day he shall re-imburse the club the nomination fee.

Players will be responsible for their own travel and competition expenses at a Regional level however, players winning at Regional level and requiring accommodation to compete in the relevant State Final will be financially supported to the amount of \$150 per day for each day played. This amount is deemed to include travel.

If the relevant State Final is played within 100 km of CBC support shall be limited to travel and lunch for each day the member plays. Travel shall be paid 50 cents per kilometre from CBC to and from the venue of the competition.

State Competitions

It is the clubs policy that competition at State and National level be encouraged but financial support shall be limited to members playing in and being successful in Nepean Highlander Regional events.

No financial support shall be given to players nominating themselves in State or National events or events run by other clubs and/or regions.

Juniors

Junior members selected in Region and State teams which provide accommodation shall receive travel expenses to the value of 50 cents per kilometre from CBC to and from the venue of the competition.

Champion of Champions

The club will pay any entry fee to State Champion of Champions only. No travel or accommodation to be paid.
